Checking In

Upon arrival at Plymouth State University, on Monday, July 26th, follow signs to FCA Camp Area to complete registration. Camp registration is between 10:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. **NO LUNCH IS SERVED ON MONDAY.** The program officially begins with the Opening Team Meeting at 1:15 p.m.

Be sure to bring your completed "Student/Participant Permission Waiver" Form (available online) and a copy of your insurance card to registration with you.

Fees

All unpaid fees are due before check-in at Camp. Any balance remaining after the Camp has ended will be subject to a \$10 per camper late fee.

Cancellations can be made as late as the time of on-site check-in by calling the FCA Camp Office at 1-866-269-2267. All fees, **EXCEPT A \$100 SERVICE FEE**, will be refunded in August if you cancel your enrollment before on-site Camp registration ends.

Substitutions can be made as late as the time of on-site check-in.

After Camp begins, \$100 is non-refundable if you do not attend Camp.

Key Deposit: No deposit required, however, a **\$45 fee will be charged to the enrollee for a lost key.**

Directions

Albany, New York– I-90E (Mass. Pike) to I-495N. I-93N to Exit 25, Plymouth.* **Boston, Massachusetts** – I-93N to Exit 25, Plymouth.* **Burlington, Vermont** (and upstate New York) – I-89S to Exit 17. Rt. 4E to Rt. 118, Canaan, to Rt. 25E. Six miles to traffic circle, continue three miles on Rt. 25 (Tenney Mountain Highway) through two lights. Take first exit after third light.* **Hartford, Connecticut** – Rt. I-84E to I-90E (Mass. Pike). Exit I-495N to I-93N to Exit 25, Plymouth.* **New York City (points south)** – I-287N to I-684N to I-84E to I-90E. Exit I-495N to I-93N, to Exit 25, Plymouth.* **Portland, Maine** – I-95 to Exit 47 to Rt. 25 W to Meredith. Rt. 3S to Route 104W to I-93N to Exit 25, Plymouth.* (see below)

*Right at end of ramp, ¼ miles to roundabout

For Campers: Go through roundabout to High Street. Plymouth State University is on the right. Follow signs to FCA. (you can also check www.Plymouth.edu)

For Staff: *right at 1st street on roundabout and then 2nd left, Langdon Woods is straight ahead.

Early Arrival

The first Camp meal is Monday evening at 5:30 p.m. Any housing or meals prior to Monday's dinner will have to be arranged and paid for by the camper.

What to Wear and Bring

Modest attire is required at all times during Camp. Keep your clothing and equipment simple and bring shoes and equipment you will need for the competition and clinic sessions.

NOTE:
Bring sheets, blanket, pillow, pillowcases, towels, washcloths toiletries, a fan and snacks

Game equipment such as basketballs will be provided. Bring personal gear such as shorts, tee shirts, sport shoes, knee pads, etc. Please bring the following gear with you to Camp, according to your sport: **Basketball** (appropriate shoes); **Cross Country** (appropriate shoes); **Lacrosse** (stick, helmet/goggles, pads and cleats); **Soccer** (cleats, ball, and pads); **Football** (helmets/cleats); **Frisbee** (appropriate footwear)

Bring your own water bottle and sun block. A notebook and a pen or pencil will be needed for the Team Meetings.

Do not bring jewelry, radios, cd players, iPods, electronic games, cell phones, computers or other expensive items.

Insurance

FCA will only provide secondary insurance coverage for the camper during the stay at Camp. In case of injury or illness, campers will need to provide proof of insurance coverage at the time of treatment. A photocopy of your insurance card will be sufficient. Campers not covered by family insurance will be cared for.

Departing Camp
