Colorado Springs FCA has had such an incredibly fast moving season. It is drawing me to new levels of faith and trust in God (because that's the only way I can keep up with it ☺). I am so encouraged to know that you all pray for us and for the harvest to which God has sent us. Please diligently carry on in this work. Our student leaders, as you know, have undergone biblical training to equip and empower them to be witnesses in their spheres of influence. On Jan 20 we challenged each of these leaders to find at least one peer to whom they would begin teaching the Word of God. On Jan 27 I was blown away when *every single* student came back having found this person or persons! I was amazed to see their faithfulness and excitement to fulfill the Great Commission (Mt 28:18-20)...and they are only High Schoolers! So we commissioned each one, praying over them that they would have the wisdom and anointing to go forth and accomplish this call. This strategy is bringing the saving message of Jesus Christ and the Kingdom of God to unsaved people in our public schools. It is so revolutionary. No one has found a way to keep prayer out of schools in Colorado Springs ☺. Here are a few testimonies that have come back from these kids ministering...

- 1) Andrea is leading a bible study on purity with 4-6 other girls. Many of them are sexually active. They ask questions about what is right and wrong and how to say no. One particular freshmen feels tremendous pressure to give in to her boyfriends advances, yet has stood strong because of Andrea's influence.
- 2) Sean is leading a bible study with a friend who has had no exposure to the Gospel! His friend is soaking it all in and it's "definitely enlightening him" according to Sean ☺.
- 3) Tyler is leading 2 Freshmen football teammates and they are "praying and diving into the scriptures" together. He said "it's powerful to see their faces light up when you talk about living all out for Jesus Christ."

These are only a few stories. These kids will build the Kingdom of God for the rest of their lives...who can measure the eternal impact?

Pray that God continues to send us workers (Lk 10:2) and builds up the ones we have.
