## Phoenix Busses (Registration)

Registration begins Friday, July 3rd at 7:30 am at North Phoenix Baptist Church parking lot (The SE corner of Central and Bethany Home). Buses will depart from Phoenix at 8:15 am. Bussing is provided for every camper coming from Phoenix and the surrounding areas. If you have an alternate plan for transportation to Flagstaff, please notify our director at [bberger@fca.org](mailto:bberger@fca.org). The busses will return to North Phoenix Baptist Church on Monday, July 6<sup>th</sup> at approximately 5:00 PM. Please make proper arrangements for pick-up.

Every camper must be paid in full with a medical waiver in our file before boarding a bus.

## Tucson Busses (Registration)

Registration begins Friday, July 3rd at 6:00 am at the Walmart on Cortaro and I-10 (west of the freeway). Buses will depart from Tucson at 7:00 am. Bussing is provided for every camper coming from Tucson and the surrounding areas. If you have an alternate plan for transportation to Flagstaff, please notify our director at [bberger@fca.org](mailto:bberger@fca.org). The busses will return to Walmart on Monday, July 6<sup>th</sup> at approximately 6:30 PM. Please make proper arrangements for pick-up.

Every camper must be paid in full with a medical waiver in our file before boarding a bus.

## Flagstaff Arrival (Registration)

Registration for campers not traveling on busses from Phoenix or Tucson will take place from 9:30 AM-12:30 PM at Northern Arizona University. Boys will be registered at their dorm, McConnell Hall. Girls will be registered at their dorm, Gabaldon Hall. There will be signs to follow.

### **\*Directions to Gabaldon Hall (For Girls Registration)**

From 1-17 North to Gabaldon Hall:

1. Take the McConnell exit and turn right (East) at the stop sign onto McConnell drive.
2. Turn left at the second stop sign onto Knoles Dr.
3. Turn right onto Gabaldon Dr. This street leads you to Gabaldon Hall (on the right).

### **\*Directions to McConnell Hall (For Boys Registration)**

From 1-17 North to McConnell Hall:

1. Take the McConnell exit and turn right at the stop sign onto McConnell drive.
2. Turn right at the first stop sign onto Pine Knoll Dr (heading South).
3. Follow Pine Knoll around past parking lot P44 and turn left (no street names).
4. This street leads you to McConnell Hall.

## What to Bring

You must bring sheets, blanket (or sleeping bag), pillow, towel, washcloth, soap, sun block, and toiletries.

Modest attire is required at all times during Camp. The climate can be warm during the day and cool at night. Keep your clothing and equipment simple.

Bring shoes and equipment you will need for the work-out and clinic sessions. Football, Baseball, and softball campers should bring both cleats and tennis shoes.

Game equipment, such as balls, will be provided. It's a good idea to bring your own water bottle and small fan for your room. A notebook and a pen will also be needed.

**Do not bring jewelry, radios, tape/CD players or other expensive items. (FCA is not responsible for lost or stolen items.)**

## Insurance

FCA will only provide secondary insurance coverage during Camp. In case of injury or illness the camper will need to provide proof of insurance coverage at the time of treatment. Thus, **campers will not be allowed to board bus without a completed medical release form.** Campers not covered by family insurance will be cared for.
