- Take the McConnell exit and turn right at the stop sign onto McConnell drive.
- Turn right at the first stop sign onto Pine Knoll Dr (heading South.)
- Follow Pine Knoll around past parking lot P44 and turn left (no street names).
- This street leads you to McConnell Hall.
