Campus

Reaching well over 3,500 teenagers in Greater Fort Worth on a weekly basis, the Campus program is initiated and led by student-athletes and coaches on junior high, high school and college campuses. The Campus program includes Huddles (FCA's Christian based positive peer group club), One Way 2 Play - Drug Free! Program, Team Bible Studies, Chapel Program, Team FCA Membership, and Special Events.

Camps

Camps are a time of "inspiration and perspiration" for athletes and coaches to reach their potential by offering comprehensive athletic, spiritual and leadership training. The types of Camps are Sports Camp, Leadership Camp, Coaches Camp, Youth Sports Camp and Partnership Camp.

Coaches

At the heart of FCA are coaches. Our role is to encourage and equip them to be positive role models and to use their great influence in the schools to build the leaders of tomorrow. FCA assists coaches through Bible studies, staff contacts, prayer support, discipleship and mentoring, Behind the Bench (a program for coaches wives), resources, outreach events, national and local conventions, conferences and retreats.

Community

The non-school based FCA programs reach the community through partnerships with the local churches, businesses, parents and volunteers. These programs not only reach out to the community, but also allow the community to invest in athletes and coaches. Community programs include: Area-wide events, Adult Huddles, FCA Membership, Urban Initiatives, Global Sports Development, Clinics, Product and Re-

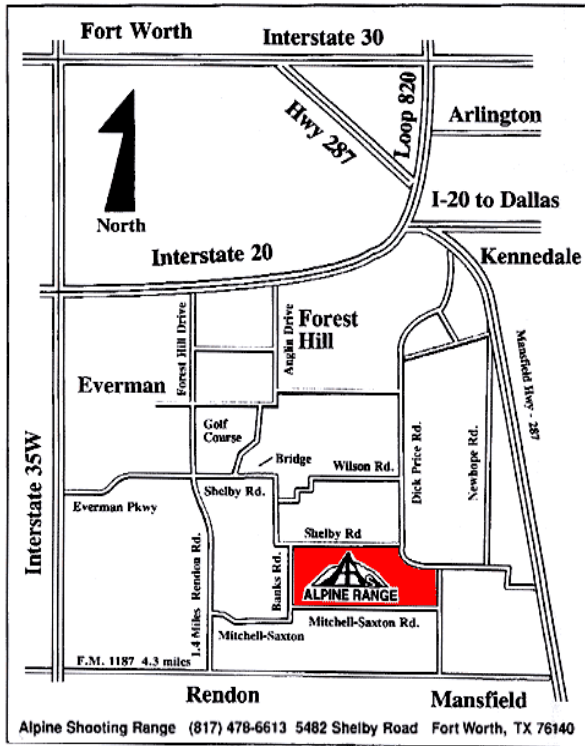
