Players' Code of Conduct

1. I understand and agree that my education is an important responsibility and that I must maintain a Grade Point Average that meets the expectations of my school, my parents and myself.

Parent's Code of Conduct

1. I will encourage good sportsmanship in my son for all players, coaches and officials at every game, practice or other team event.
